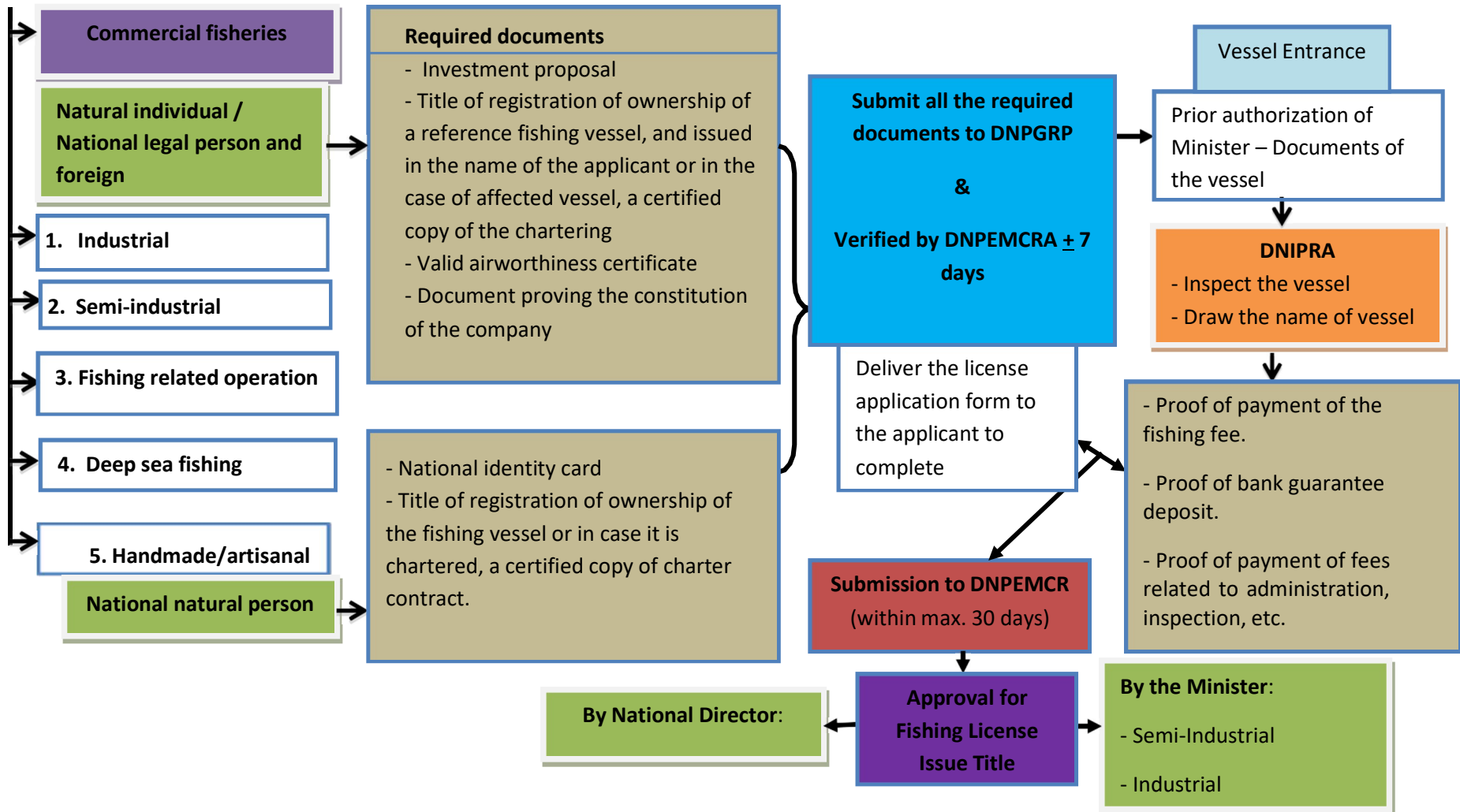


DIAGRAM

IMPORT AND EXPORT PROCEDURES

FISHING PRODUCTS

Prior to Import and Export

1. Submit an official application to the Director of DGPARM in order to obtain recommendation to their import and export activities.
2. The delivered application should with the names of each species (fish, crustacean, cephalopod, algae and etc)
3. The application should include with a valid commercial license issued from SERVE I.P.
4. Joined inspection team from DGPRM-DNPEMCRA-DNIPRA will conduct an inspection to the place of importer (in case the importer is new).
5. The importer and exporter will submit import recommendation to DNQB to obtain import/export permit.

AFTER IMPORT AND EXPORT

1. Submit a copy of Quality Certificate (Health Certificate) from origin nation to DGPRM-DNPEMCRA-DNIPRA
2. Submit a copy of "Import and Export Permit" document from DNQB to DGPRM-DNPEMCRA-DNIPRA
3. Submit copies of other relevant documents link to Import/Export activities to DGPRM-DNPEMCRA-DNIPRA.
